This course examines the historical, economic and social reasons that led to the creation of the European Economic Community and later the European Union, its structure and main instruments, as well as the reasons, principles and objectives for the creation of the Common Agricultural Policy (CAP). In particular, the principles and fundamental mechanisms of exercising the structural and financial policies of the CAP are analyzed in relation to the basic problems of rural sectors of the Member States and the characteristics of its periodical revisions. A subject of specific examination is the position and distinctiveness of the Greek Agricultural Sector in the CAP framework and the impact of its individual policies and measures.
