To give students a brief but as it becomes more global, multilevel and interdisciplinary description of developments in the Greek political system after the fall of the dictatorship and until the late 20th century. For this reason it also examines issues such as the conditions that led to the end of the dictatorship, the importance of political parties in the new framework, the structures of the new political system, the creation of the party system in the period 1974-1981, the government of PASOK and the formation of the masse party of the New Democracy , the neoliberal period of rule by the New Democracy in the early'90's, the strategy of Modernization of PASOK etc.
